SERVICE CONTRACT COVERAGE

This **Chassis - EVC for Severe Service** (this “Service Contract”) provides coverage for 12 months or up to 750,000 total odometer miles (1,207,008 total odometer kilometers) traveled from the contract purchase date, whichever expiration occurs first. Vehicles with 600,000 miles (965,606.4 total odometer kilometers) or greater traveled per vehicle from the contract purchase date are not eligible for coverage under this Service Contract. For qualified units the coverage under this Service Contract expires at 750,000 total odometer miles (1,207,008 total odometer kilometers) even if prior to the 12 month threshold. Qualified units are outlined by model year and mileage at time of purchase as defined by the contract policy number.

During this period, Navistar, Inc (“Navistar”) will repair or replace any of the covered components as defined below which proven defective in material and/or workmanship in normal use, with new International® service parts or ReNEWed® parts.
