Managed the engage the rotors and got the rotor speed up to 1400rpm.

Shut the thresher down.

Inspected the hydraulic sheave and found that the rotary union was leaking.

Spoke to the customer and decided that the union had to be replaced.

Looked up the part and it showed we had none in stock.

Customer is going to source one themselves.

Removed the hydraulic hose from the union.

Removed the 3 bolts from the sheave and removed the washer. Pulled the union out.

While waiting for the customer, the customer had requested we change the elevator drive belt. Had a new belt delivered.

Removed the tension from the old belt and removed the belt. Installed the new belt.

Had to wait for the customer to return with the new union.

When the customer returned, installed the new union.

Reinstalled the washer and bolts to secure the union in. Swapped the fitting over from the old union and installed

it onto the new one.

Reinstalled the hydraulic hose.

Started the combine and engaged the thresher. Moved the rotor speed up and down.

The rotors would only get as low as about 780 rpm and the belt was extremely loose and flopping around. Shut the thresher down.

Inspected the mechanical sheave and found that the sheave was not closing all the way.

The customer requested we try and work it free. Applied plenty of grease to the sheave and used the push off bolts to open and close the sheave repeatedly to try and work it

The sheave would still not close. Decided to remove it. Removed the bridge bolts and removed the bridge from both

Used the push off bolts to completely open the sheave and removed the hydraulic line from the hydraulic sheave to open it all the way.

Removed the elevator drive belt and tensioner.

Removed the variator belt from the mechanical sheave.

Removed the 6 bolts securing the bridge hub and removed the hub.

Removed the rotary screen vacuum tube.

Loosened the center bolt on the sheave and installed a puller. Used the puller to pop the sheave off the gearbox shaft.

Supported the weight of the sheave with a sling and the service truck crane and removed the sheave.

Placed the sheave in the back of the truck to take back to the shop to disassemble.

Cleaned up work area and put tools away.

Sep 16: At the shop, installed the sheave compression tool and compressed the spring to remove the snap ring.

Removed the snap ring and decompressed the spring until it was completely loose.

Disassembled the sheave.

Found that the ramps on the inside of the sheaves had broken and pieces were stuck in the bottom preventing the

Arrived at the combine. Lifted the sheave onto the shaft of the gearbox with the crane. Reinstalled the center bolt and tightened it. Reinstalled the bridge hub onto the sheave and tightened the 6 hex socket bolts. Reinstalled the push off bolts to completely open the Reinstalled the variator belt. Removed the push off bolts and reinstalled the hydraulic line on the hydraulic variator. Reinstalled the elevator drive belt and tensioner. Applied tension to the belt. Reinstalled the rotary screen vacuum tube. Started the combine and engaged the thresher. Ran the rotors through their whole speed range. Belt stayed tight. Cleaned up work area and put tools away.
