CASE Construction is offering an Extended Service Plan, your CASE Construction Dealer will provide you with further information relating to this plan.

This Warranty Registration Document also contains the following forms: Delivery and Warranty Registration;
Safety Acknowledgement; Identification Details;
Pre Delivery Check List; and
Follow Up Service.

Please ensure you allow adequate time to thoroughly read and complete each form with your Dealer.

You must sign both the Delivery and Warranty Registration and Safety Acknowledgement at the time of delivery of the CASE Construction Product.

Your Dealer will then upload the completed documentation online. Your Dealer will then email you a copy and retain a copy for its records.

You and all operator/s of the CASE Construction product should be fully acquainted with the Operator's Manual as it sets out the CASE Construction product service along with instructions for its correct and safe operation.

Your Dealer will carry out one Follow Up Service within the first 100 hours of operation or 6 months from the Warranty registration date (whichever occurs first). This is an important follow up service check for the product.

Please contact your Dealer for a time that is mutually convenient to have this service check completed. The labour component of this Follow Up Service will be free of charge. However, you will be liable for all costs for travel, consumables and non-warrantable components.

CASE Construction wishes you every success with the CASE Construction product and look forward to servicing your needs now and into the future.

In addition to McIntosh Holdings Pty Limited (McIntosh), your personal information may be shared amongst CNHI Industrial Australia Pty Limited and its related entities (the CNHI Group). The CNHI Group is bound by the provisions of the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) in its handling of your personal information. It may also be shared with Technology Services Providers (TSPs) engaged by the CNHI Group for the purpose of charting customer experience and conducting surveys. The CNHI Group has agreements in place with these TSPs to ensure your personal information is protected and used only for those purposes. WARRANTY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Warranty commences from the date of delivery and continues until the end of the Period. The Warranty only takes effect once the Product is registered with MCE. The terms and conditions of the Warranty may only be varied by the Managing Director of MCE in MCE's sole discretion.

DEFINITIONS

Customer means the owner referred to in the Delivery and Warranty Registration form of this book and any subsequent owner of the Product who has signed a Notice of Transfer and is registered with Case Construction.

Dealer means an authorised CASE Construction Dealer.

Product means the unit referred to in the Delivery and Warranty Registration form of this book and includes accessories installed by the Dealer at the time of retail sale to the Customer.

Accessories means Case Construction approved accessories intended and designed to be used in conjunction with Case Construction Products.

Operator's Manual means the manual supplied by the Dealer upon sale of the Product to the Customer.

Period is when the month or machine hour ends, whichever occurs first.

Notice of Transfer means the notice transferring the Warranty to any subsequent owner contained in this book.

CUSTOMER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The Customer must:

- Arrange for the required maintenance at the recommended intervals specified in the Operator's Manual
- Ensure the Product is operated in the application for which it was intended and within its rated capacity
- Use genuine parts and lubricants for maintenance and repairs
- Notify the Dealer of a claim under the Warranty within 14 days of becoming aware of the defect giving rise to the claim
- Must make the Product available for repairs under the Warranty within 30 days of notifying of the claim subject to the Dealer's availability
- Transport the Product at their own risk to the Dealer location or accept and pay any costs incurred by the Dealer in travelling to the Product to carry out investigation or repair of the Product
- Ensure all scheduled services are performed by an Authorised Dealer.

WHAT'S EXCLUDED GENERALLY

Replacement and Repair

Replacement of:

- Non-defective wear items expected to be replaced during the Period including but not limited to fuses, belts; batteries;
- Items otherwise replaced by the Customer or at the Customer's request; and
- Normal maintenance parts and service items, including but not limited to lubricants, coolants, filters; engine belts and thermostats.
- Wear & tear, ground engaging tracks, or other ground engaging undercarriage components.\

Repairs due to:

- The failure to properly maintain or care for the Product including failure to keep the Product clean from dust and environmental containments, use of unsuitable accessories or attachments with the Product;
- General misuse and abuse of the Product including but not limited to overloading and/or the operation of Product beyond the rated capacity or specification;
- Incorrect adjustment of components and/or assemblies.

Unauthorised Use/Misuse

The Product:

- Being operated outside the recommended use as specified in the Operator's Manual; and/or
- Having Original Equipment Manufacturer (**OEM**) equipment installed outside the design specification; (**the Excluded Activities**).

The onus of proving the Repairs are not due to the Product having been subjected to the Excluded Activities lies solely with the customer. The decision as to whether the Repairs are due to the Product being engaged in Excluded Activities will be referred to a Case Construction technical specialist for adjudication. The decision by the CASE Construction technical specialist will be final;

- Unauthorised repair work generally;
- Unauthorised modifications to the Product and/or Product software (including but not limited to alterations made to increase the rated engine speed and/or power, adjustments made to emissions control systems);
- Use of replacement parts or lubricants not purchased from MCE. Any parts or lubricants not purchased from MCE need prior approval; and
- Damage caused by other elements including but not limited to impact with blunt forces (including the striking of hidden objects during use), incorrect storage of the Product, collisions, vandalism, environmental factors and fire events.

Products Not Manufactured by CASE Construction

Items not manufactured by CASE Construction and warranted by their respective manufacturer, including without limitation: batteries; fuel injection equipment; starter motors and alternators, and attachments or other accessory items.

Labour Cost of Removing Non CASE Construction Accessories

If it is necessary to remove non-CASE Construction attachments and accessory items during a warranty repair, the Customer will bear the cost of having the item removed.

Consequential Losses

Economic loss, including loss of profits, equipment downtime, equipment rental or other costs.

LIMITATIONS OF WARRANTY

Subject to the following, the Warranty is your sole remedy.

To the fullest extent permitted by law all express or implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose (or fitness for any other purpose) and liability which may be imposed at common law (including but not limited to negligence) are excluded from the Warranty. Nothing in the Warranty will be taken as excluding, restricting or modifying any condition, guarantee, warranty, right or liability which cannot by law be excluded restricted or modified by the Warranty.

Where a condition, warranty, right or liability cannot be excluded by law, then to the extent permissible by law, Case Construction's liability for a breach of the condition, warranty or right is limited to at Case Construction's option:

1. Replacement of the Product or the cost of replacing; or
2. Repair of the Product or payment of the cost of having the Product repaired.

The benefits provided under this Warranty are in addition to other rights and remedies you have at law if the Product has been purchased for personal, household or domestic use. Those additional rights and remedies are set out in the statutory warranty below.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or a refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

CASE Construction may make design changes across its range of Products and other changes to improve the performance of its products. Should the Product fall within a product range which has been subject to such a change, Case Construction shall not be obliged to update/upgrade the Product to reflect the change. Case Construction will only be obliged to make changes to the Product as part of an authorised Product Improvement Program (**PIP**) or otherwise as a product recall.
