## 5.19 Rural Industrial Zone (MR)

## 5.19.1 Uses Permitted

No person shall, within any MR Zone, use any lot or erect, alter or use any building or structure for any purpose except one or more of the following uses, namely:

- (a) Agricultural Industrial Establishment
- (b) Agricultural Processing Establishment
- (c) Agricultural Service Establishment
- (d) Agricultural Supply Establishment
- (e) Clinic, Veterinary
- (f) Feed or Flour Mill
- (g) Grading Station for farm product
- (h) Grain Elevator or other Storage Facility for farm produce
- (i) Industrial Use If a municipal water supply is not available, only a Dry Industry shall be permitted
- (j) Nursery
- (k) Public Storage
- (I) Retail Store engaged in the sale of farm produce
- (m) Service Trade Establishment primarily serving the rural community
- (n) Truck Terminal
- (o) Warehouse
- (p) Uses and Buildings accessory to the above permitted uses

## 5.19.2 Regulations

Each use permitted in a Rural Industrial Zone (MR) is subject to:

- (a) the regulations in Section 4:
- (b) the regulations detailed in the following Performance Standard Chart applicable to the zone; and
- (c) any exceptions referred to in Schedule "B" applicable to the land, building or structure.
