Pollock Ranching was established in 1883 on the north slope of the Cypress Hills as a horse ranch with a herd of 800 horses trailed up from Winnemucca Nevada. They supplied horses to the Northwest Mounted Police at Fort Walsh and surrounding area. It has since transitioned to a cattle ranch currently running 300 mother cows.
