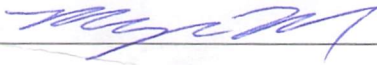

Your insurance must provide public liability and property damage coverage under an owner's automobile insurance policy, as provided for in the *Alberta Insurance Act*. It is an offence punishable by law, either to apply for or obtain registration of a motor vehicle when it is not insured or to operate an uninsured motor vehicle.

Your motor vehicle must not be operated in any manner that contravenes the provisions of the insurance policy or when the policy is cancelled or has expired.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The 'registered owner of an Alberta Licence Plate' is the person to whom that licence plate is linked in the Motor Vehicles System. If a vehicle is sold, traded or otherwise disposed of, the registrant(s) must keep the plate(s) or return them to a registry agent for disposal, if no longer required. The registrant(s) of a non-returned plate continue to be linked to and accountable for that plate.

The purchaser (including any dealer) must present a Bill of Sale when applying for the registration of the vehicle in Alberta. For future reference, you should retain copies of any Bill of Sale or other ownership documents. The Registrar cannot confirm the legal owner of a vehicle as vehicle registration is not proof of ownership.

In accordance with the *Traffic Safety Act (TSA)* and *Operator Licensing and Vehicle Control Regulation*, when making an application for a motor vehicle service, the Registrar of Motor Vehicles will collect specific personal information to confirm the identity and eligibility of an individual for motor vehicle services and for motor vehicle records held by Motor Vehicles in the administration of the TSA. Information and numbers from personal documents recorded on this form are not copied to any other Motor Vehicle database and serve as a source of information should a future investigation into your service be required, i.e., identity theft. The physical address is required as the Registrar needs the location of an individual's residence at which documents can be personally served under the Act.
