WARRANTY COVERAGE:

The purchase of any rebuilt engine from Armor Inc is covered by the following warranty specifications and protects the original buyer from defects in material and/or workmanship. Armor Inc will determine the course of action regarding the repair and/or replacement of engine. Any refund or compensation for warranty is at the sole discretion of Armor Inc and all decisions made by Armor Inc are final. All warrantable claims must be returned with a complete service history, mileage of vehicle at installation and current mileage at time of claim as well as proof of purchase. Armor Inc will cover defects in the workmanship and/or material. Our 5 year 160,000km will cover fluids and gasket leaks for a period of 1 year from the date of purchase we will cover parts and labour, the second year we will cover parts only. Armor Inc will cover labour rate limited to \$70.00 shop rate using Mitchell Flat Rate times.

This warranty will be nullified and Armor Inc will be relieved from any responsibility

- 1) Original buyer must submit warranty registration form within 30 days or warranty will be VOID.

- 2) Regular scheduled maintenance must be performed on engine.
- 3) Maintenance records may be requested to validate warranty on engine.
- 4) Engine will or may need additional accessories or components which must be correctly installed or warranty may be void.
- 5) Warranty will not include defects or failures caused by:
 - In a case of accident, abusiveness, alteration, either drive train or suspension from the specified manufacturer's terms.
 - Improperly installation
 - Improper application and conversions
 - Improper oil is deposited into motor
 - Engine is ran without oil
 - Engine is ran out of oil due to leaks
 - Improper maintenance that is required to maintain warranty.

(Armor Inc will not obtain any responsibility for cost of regular maintenance)

6) Original buyer acknowledges:

- That they must notify Armor Inc of any warranty claim prior to repair.
- Armor Inc reserves the right to inspect the engine if a warranty claim has been filed.
- The original buyer will be required to deliver/ship the engine to Armor Inc for further inspection where considered necessary.
- Failure to comply will result in a voided warranty.
- Warranty claim form must be filled out and returned to Armor Inc the same day Armor Inc was informed of the problem involving the motor.
- Any warranty claim may take up to 5-10 working days before it is resolved.
- No engine can be returned for warranty if it is disassembled.

This warranty does not cover damage caused by the following for rebuilt engines:

- Injectors
- Injection pump failure
- Incorrect fluid used in engine
- Overheating
- Incorrect servicing of engine
- Engine dusting
- Melted pistons from failed injectors

7) The original buyer agrees that Armor Inc will NOT be liable for:

- Incidental or consequential damages
- Lost profits, sales or income
- Injury to person or property
- Oil, antifreeze, fluids or other substances
- Towing charges
- Lift, dock or storage fees
- Communication fees
- Freight
- Substitute transportation, lodging, etc.
- Unauthorized repairs

8) This warranty is VOID for any engine if it is purchased through private sale, change of ownership or through any Internet sales/auction websites.

In order to be eligible for the 5 year/160,000km warranty you must follow all instructions and replace all parts specified:

If install is not done at one of our shops then the installer must show with receipts that new fluids, filters and seals were used upon installation of the engine. All coolers, lines,

› radiators, oil coolers are to be flushed before the engine install to ensure that there is no crossover contamination and premature failure from previous engine issues. All of these details must be preformed and documented or warranty is void. The following parts water pump, lubricating oil, oil/air/fuel filters must also be changed and documented as to receive any warranty. Only non synthetic oil must be used for the first 20,000km or warranty will be void. All documents stating the above was complete must be dated within the time frame of the engine install

9) Core deposit will be returned in whole or part be based on the following (Core Refunds may take up to 3-5 weeks):

- NO holes in the block or the head
- NO melted valves or scaring to head
- NO scaring or melting of block to deep to be machined
- NO bent rods
- NO bearing issues causing scaring over heated ends
- NO scaring to crank or cam
- NO scaring or issues with tappets
- No dents or broken timing cases, timing covers, rear seal housing or oil pan.
- All parts including proper paperwork, block, rods, crank, cam, valve train, head, bolts, oil pan and the pallet the engine was shipped on must be returned in good order within 30 days or warranty will be void and core charge will NOT be returned

FOR FULL WARRANTY AND CORE RETURN ALL STIPULATIONS MUST BE MET IN FULL.

If vehicle is sold with an Armor Inc reman engine warranty can be transferred to new owner if the new owner comes in to Armor Inc within 7 days of registering the vehicle and fills out the proper paper work.

****All non-commercial engines are covered for the 5 year 150,000km. Any fluid leaks are covered for the first year of the engine. The initial warranty of 3 years 100,000km is parts and labor warranty, the remaining 2 years 50,000km is parts only.**
